2. EU PRIVACY NOTICE

3. INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We collect certain information to help us operate and provide the website. If you do not wish to provide us with the following information, please send us an email to tintoamor@ecocharco.org and do not use our website anymore.

We automatically collect this information when you use the Website, including:

- Information about the device(s) you use to access the Website, including MAC address, IP address, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform, device type, and device identifiers;
- Information about your visits to the website, including the full URL clickstream to, through and from these websites (including date and time);
- Information we need and use to facilitate your use of the website (including to provide access to third party websites and website), such as URL requests, destination IP addresses, or device configuration details;
- Website pages and listings you viewed or searched for, page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), and methods used to browse away from the page.

We may also use technologies to automatically collect tracking information on your mobile device or your browser. The technologies include:

- Cookies and mobile cookies. A cookie is a small file placed on your computer or mobile device. We may use cookies and similar technologies to support the functionality of our website. This provides a better experience when you use our website and allows us to improve our website. It may be possible to refuse to accept cookies or mobile cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser or smartphone. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our website.
- Behavior tracking. We may use technologies, which can collect information about your activities on our website such as Google Analytics.

4. HOW YOUR INFORMATION IS USED

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including but not limited to any Personal Information to:

- Provide you with information offered on our website.
- Perform any data analysis necessary to perform our website, including administration, internal operations, troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes.
- Provide you with any other information from us including subscription to get news and updates about Ecocharco activities.
- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Comply with applicable laws and regulations and other legal requirements.
- Maintain the security of our Website.
